HSSN 14: Sunshine and Rain

Måne och sol is one of the most well-known contemporary hymns in Scandinavia. Britt G. Hallqvist, a Swede, wrote the text for the hymn which would serve as the Laudamus of a liturgy she had written for families. She sent it to Egil Hovland in Norway. When he got the text he had just heard a very good friend and colleague had died. The letter from Hallqvist was the first he had heard from her. When he saw the text, he could imagine the heads of those in his children's choir taking their place like notes on a staff. He then wrote down the melody. That began their lifelong cooperation. They went on to write many hymns for the new hymnals of the late 20th century. They also wrote several bible plays, two of which we have done in Mindekirken, an operetta, the Christmas Rose, and an opera on the life and work of Hans Nielsen Hauge, Fange og Fri/Captive and Free. It has become a favorite of school children in Norway, Sweden and Finland.



HSSN BE 58: *Who Can Tell the Joy and Gladness*


Lars Oftedal, the founder of the Betania-kvarteret in Stavanger, where he built a Bedehus, orphanage and home for unwed mothers, was also a newspaper editor and member of the Norwegian Parliament. Oftedal, who published a popular songbook in 1875, wrote this hymn after a scandal in 1891. Famous for his warmhearted preaching and spiritual leadership, he confessed to his church that he had not appropriately behaved in a relationship with a woman. Although he continued as editor of Stavanger Aftenblad, Oftedal was ruined by this confession and died in 1900. This hymn is regarded by many as his statement after his downfall in which he rejoices in the grace of God.






